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### A HISTORIC MONTH: HANDWRITTEN BIBLE TRAINING — A LEGACY BEGINS

November has been a month of new beginnings for the Bible Society of Namibia. We are grateful to share the start of a beautiful journey — the Handwritten Bible Project.

#### Learning from Uganda — A Legacy That Inspires

On 18 November, we hosted a very special training session for the Handwritten Bible Project. We were honored to learn from Mr. Jesse Mungalo of the Bible Society of Uganda, whose team successfully completed their own Handwritten Bible. A total of eight participants were trained during this impactful session.

Mr. Jesse shared the story of how Uganda's project united people from all walks of life. What touched many hearts was hearing how their Handwritten Bible created a long-lasting legacy — it played a major role in helping Uganda build their Bible Society offices. This showed us that when people come together with faith and purpose, great things can happen.

Some participants said the session was inspiring and meaningful. They learned how the writing process works, the vision behind the project, and how powerful it can be when a nation writes God's Word together.

This training marked the beginning of our own journey — one filled with hope, unity, and the possibility of leaving a legacy for future generations in Namibia.

This project not only deepens our connection to Scripture but also strengthens our mission to make God's Word accessible to all.

### Why Handwritten?

Because every verse we copy becomes a prayer and a testimony, together we are building a legacy. By joining hands as a nation—building unity, sharing faith, and creating something that will be a blessing for generations to come—we follow the example of Uganda's Handwritten Bible project, trusting that our project will bring hope, and transformation to our communities.

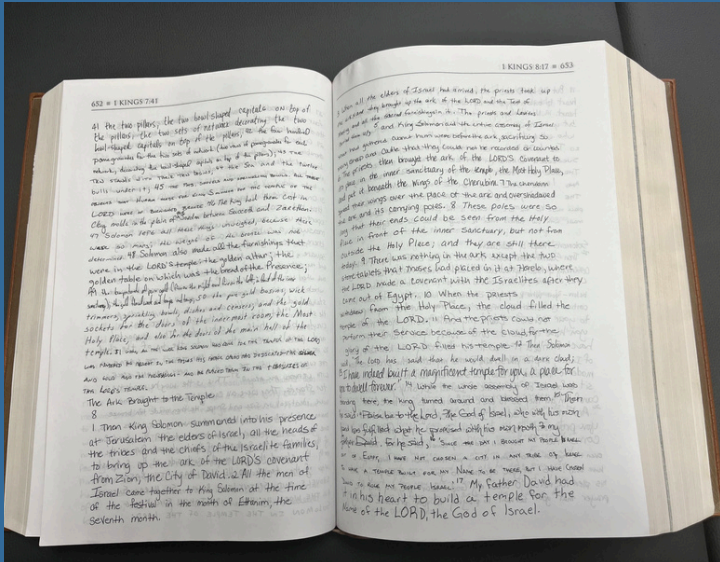

### Awareness Sessions

Trauma Healing Network conducted an awareness session in collaboration with Namibian Health Plan (NHP) at the SOS Children's Village as part of their Wellness Day. During this event, we worked closely with the SOS staff, sharing important information and facilitating a wellness session. Further, Trauma Healing Network was invited by Frans Indongo Primary School, where we had an awareness session with the staff focusing on their well-being. The teachers were highly engaged with the session and expressed their appreciation.

### A Story of Four Friends Graduation

In the month of October, Trauma Healing Network celebrated the learners from Frans Indongo Primary School and Elim Primary School of the Grades 4's and 5's who completed the seven sessions journey of the Four Friends program. The Story of Four Friends program focuses on teaching children how to handle their emotions in a biblical and spiritual way. Many of our learners go through difficult experiences, and this program helps them understand their feelings while finding comfort and guidance through the word with faith. After the seven sessions the learners graduated and received participant certificates and small gifts. The children learned, shared their experiences and expressed their growth.
